# Principal's Message

A big thank you to our students and parents for your understanding and messages of support during the past week. It has been a challenging time, but our focus has been on keeping our community COVID-safe. Your kind words have been hugely appreciated. We send our love to you and your families too. Thank you!

In our return from our school closure, our focus is on every child's safety and wellbeing. To keep everyone safe, as per the Advice from NSW Health, we continue to urge all parents and carers not to send children to school if they are unwell - even if they have the mildest flu-like symptoms. Anyone who is unwell or has even mild flu-like symptoms should have a COVID test through their local medical practitioner or one of the COVID-19 clinics.

#### **Emergency Contact Details**

It is important that your contact details are up-to-date with our School Office. If your mobile or email details are incorrect, you may miss important emergency information. A note will go home this week to help support parents provide the most current information to the office.

To Drop off and Pick Up students safely, please use the designated gate:

Gate 1 (Pedestrian/New Hall Gate) - Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2

Gate 2 (Bus Stop/OOSH Gate) - Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6

Gate 3 (Sackville Road Gate) - Preschool, Support Unit students and Family Groups



Drop Off Time: 8.30 to 9.00am - the teacher on duty will monitor students entering the school

Pick-Up Time: 3.00pm – the class teacher will monitor students leaving the gate (1 class at a time)

We request that parents stay 'COVID Safe' near the gates and pedestrian crossings. Please don't crowd around the gates, where possible remain in your car.

#### When dropping off and picking up children:

Please ensure you follow COVID social distancing outside gates 1.5 metre guidelines

#### Wear a mask

Fully vaccinated parents and carers will be allowed on site to support curriculum delivery, vulnerable students or students with disability, student wellbeing activities and school operations (for example reading support, canteens and uniform shops). Parents and carers must check in using the school check-in, show proof of vaccination on entry to the school site and follow mask-wearing requirements.

One fully vaccinated parent or carer is permitted to attend their child's Kindergarten orientation when conducted outdoors. For more information, refer to Kindergarten orientation and transition.

Parents and carers must follow their school's advice regarding student drop-off and pick-up, which will usually require parents to remain off school sites at these times. This includes staying in the car when dropping off and picking up children if it is safe to do so. This does not apply to drop-off and pick-up from outside of school hours care (OOSHC) as sign-in and -out procedures are required for OOSHC.

# NSW Health Advice on managing Close Contact Students and their Siblings

We have had questions from parents about whether siblings of Year 6 students are allowed to be at school during the next two weeks. Here is the recommendation from the NSW Department of Health:

We understand that in some families it may be difficult to isolate children from other family members. Designate a person in your household to care for your child while they are a close contact. This carer should ideally be fully vaccinated and not have other illnesses. If the carer is fully vaccinated, they do not need to co-isolate with the child (they can leave the home) but should not enter a high risk setting (health care, aged care, disability care, early childhood centres, primary school and correctional facility) for the duration of the child's isolation period. If the carer is not fully vaccinated, they need to co-isolate with the child.

Other people in the household who are not the designated carer do not need to self-isolate unless your child tests positive for COVID-19, and as long as your child is isolated from them at all times.

I wish to advise that there will be no School Crossing Supervisor (SCS) available at the crossing at Lucas Road, Seven Hills on the 8.11.2021 to the 12.11.2021 (Morning and Afternoon).

Presently, a replacement SCS is unavailable. We will notify you if we are able to source a replacement. Please be aware, school staff/parents are not authorised to carry out the duties of the SCS and must not use the STOP Children Crossing bat and/or the Transport for NSW uniform.

Our school will place Children's Crossing flags out at the crossing the Gate 1 teacher will assist at the Pedestrian crossing. Class teachers will also remind the students of the road safety messages which are:

- Wherever possible, cross the road at a designated pedestrian crossing facility
- Stop! Look! Listen! Think! when crossing the road
- Take care whenever you cross
- Don't run across the road



## **Automated Pedestrian Gate 1**

Our new automated pedestrian gate at Gate 1 is now in operation.



Please be aware that Gate 1 will be open from 8.30am to 9.10am and 2.55pm to 3.10pm daily.

Should you need to enter the school at other times during the day – please press the buzzer – wait for the Admin office to respond – then wait until the gate opens before entering.

#### Please DO NOT push or pull on the gate.

You will also need to press the buzzer when exiting and wait for the Admin office to respond – again, please wait until the gate opens before exiting.

## **Attendance**

Student attendance records will be closely monitored. If your child is absent, it is important that a note/certificate explaining

their absence is given to the classroom teacher when your child returns to school. Parents/Carers will be given a letter if an explanation is not provided for the student's absence and this must be completed and returned to the classroom teacher so that the student's attendance records will be updated accordingly.

#### Student Absences

The Department of Education deems that all students must attend school every day. Families are also advised that holidays should be taken during school holiday periods.

If your child is absent from school please notify the school in writing by either sending an email to the school email or sending a note to the class teacher explaining the absence.

If your child is sick for one day, you DO NOT need to ring the school but can send a note to school with your child on the following day.

Absences are recorded in the class roll and this roll is admissible as evidence in a court of law.

- Partial absences are also recorded in the roll, where a child arrives late to school or leaves school early.
- If a student is late to school, a parent should escort them to the office so they can give the reason for the late arrival.
- Students, who are constantly late to school, miss the morning lesson introduction and this can lead to gaps in learning.



Please endeavour to maximize your child's attendance at school to ensure that they have the best start possible, every day!

If you are intending to take leave for more than three days, and you know in advance, it is important that this be discussed with the school as an application for leave may be required. If your child is absent for longer than three days it is important that you contact the school to let them know the reason for the absence.


Mr Nunan is very impressed with the behaviour and dedication to learning that the students in 1N have shown over the start of the term.



# **Health and Safety Matters**

As well as keeping our staff and students safe on school grounds we aim to maintain a safe environment for parents. If you have a slip, trip or fall or any other issue related to parent safety in the school grounds please notify the office as soon as possible so we can endeavour to identify and resolve any hazards.

It is also a request that dogs not be brought onto the school site without prior permission. Companion dogs are always welcome as required, however pets in the school can cause stress to students and animals.

#### Staff Car Park

A reminder to parents/caregivers. The Staff car park IS NOT a 'walk through' area or parking for area for parents.

Safety is of the utmost importance to our students and it would be appreciated if you would cooperate in regard to safety in our car park.

#### **Student Toilets**

Just a friendly reminder that student toilets are **not to be used** by parents. If parents have a younger child that requires toileting assistance, please see the office staff to access the toilets located beside the new school hall.

# **Notes and Payments**

Please be advised that all school notes and written communication are now placed on our website for your easy access. Families that have requested multiple copies will now need to access the website. We are encouraging the use of technology @ SHWPS!

#### **Important**

It would be appreciated, if when completing permission notes, you could include the child's FULL NAME (Given Name and Surname) AND CLASS, in order for the office to correctly identify the student who is participating in the special activity.

#### Sending money to school

If paying by cash or cheque, payment envelopes are available to allow office staff to quickly record details for our students.

**A reminder:** A permission note must be completed for every student in the family for all activities. Please note the office does not carry change. Please provide the correct money with your payments. We encourage families to pay using our POP – Payment online system via our school website.

#### Collection of Money and Permission Notes

To ensure that students' needs are met on excursions, extra curricula activities and for visiting performances, it is necessary

to have procedures in place regarding payments and permission notes. These procedures allow teachers to:

- Ensure that the correct number of teachers are allocated to an activity or excursion
- Buses are ordered for the right number of students
- Book correct numbers for all activities on excursions
- Organise supervision for students not involved in these activities
- Cancel activities if numbers are too low, within a reasonable timeframe.

It will also allow the office staff to have correct numbers, permission notes and money organised before the day of the activity or excursion.

These procedures include any area where money is paid to the school e.g. Excursions, visiting performances, sporting events, book club etc.

For this to be implemented correctly all money must be paid to front office by the DUE DATE, there will be no exceptions.

Permission notes, fully completed with child's name and class, must be given to the front office once you have made your payment online, or at the same time as money is presented.

In cases of financial hardship, the school *may* be able to assist by contributing a part payment.
