Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are always looking for ways to improve our students' leadership skills and to apply their learning to 'real life' situations. As some of you are already aware, Stage 3 students will be hosting a Challenge Expo on Tuesday 6th November 2018. Students from Seven Hills West PS will have the opportunity to participate in the Stage 3 Challenge Expo event with their teacher. Parents and families are very welcome to come along and join in the fun. All money raised will go towards the Year 6 Farewell, Year 6 gift to the school and contributions will be made to lower the cost of the Year 6 shirts.

Stage 3 students are working in teams to design an activity, plan the layout, organise the presentation and, in some cases, construct the activity. They will write and rehearse an advertising script to then film the advertisement to be presented in the classrooms. To ensure the safety of all students and family members, classes will be invited to participate in the activities during the following times:

10:15am-11am K-2S and 1-6C Support classes, K/1M, 1/2P and 1/2C

11:20am-12pm Preschool and Kindergarten classes

12:10pm-1pm ALL Stage 2 classes

Altogether Stage 3 students have planned and organised **25 different activities and challenges** and a Punch Card will need to be purchased to take part in the activities.

Students will need to prepay their <u>Punch Cards</u> but they will be <u>sold on the day to families</u> from 10am from the <u>ticket stall</u>. Each Punch Card holds a different value:

\$5 Punch Card – 5 activities and either a slushy OR popcorn bag.

\$10 Punch Card – 10 activities and either a slushy OR popcorn bag.

\$15 Punch Card – 18 activities and a slushy AND popcorn bag.

Students are encouraged to bring loose change on the day for:

\$1 - Hairspray

\$1 - Popcorn tokens

\$1 - Photo Booth photos (for each photo which will be developed and given to the student/s the following week)

\$2- Slushy tokens
