Home readers will soon be available for all students in K-2. The Home Reading Program compliments our homework programme to encourage children and their families to read a variety of books together on a regular basis. These will be books issued to the children additional to their library books. The books will be sent home for each class as often as possible, depending on when students return their book and change them. This year at Seven Hills West Public School we are encouraging students to take ownership of changing their own books. Your child may return a book as soon as they have finished reading it, to be changed as soon as possible.

The Home Reading Program is a positive way for you to support your child's reading and literacy development at home. It would be appreciated if you could listen to your child read at least three times each week and fill in the record card to indicate that your child has finished reading a book and needs a new one.

This system has proved to be very successful in the past. As books are expensive to replace, we must ensure all books are returned and in good condition. Home readers will only be issued to children who have returned the parent permission and agreement form. Please complete the slip below and return to the school office by Friday 15th February.
