GENERAL PROCEDURES

HOME READING PROGRAM and HOMEWORK

Homework for Kindergarten consists of home reading and sight word revision. Home reading program is well underway. As students read a book, write this down on their yellow home reader card. Once reached 25 readers, 50, 75, 100 etc.. students will be awarded a home reader certificate. Students are also encouraged as part of homework to revise the Magic 100 sight words.
