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## REMINDERS AND GENERAL PROCEDURES

- School assemblies are held on a Wednesday fortnight from 2-3 pm Via pre-recorded link.
- No adults, including parents/carers are allowed onsite.
- Therapists are now allowed onsite. Please contact your class teacher to arrange this.
- In weeks 8 / 9 we will hold Review meetings. It is important that parents/carers attend this meeting to help Review your child's progress and plan for the following year. More information will come.
- Notes explaining your child's absence are required when students are absent from school. Students who are taking extended leave need to notify the Principal in advance, via the school office.
- Home readers are not to be sent to and from home as per COVID advice from the department. We will notify you when this commences again. Homework may be sent home as normal. - It is important that parents/caregivers read all notes sent home thoroughly, as late payments would not be accepted from the front office.
