Seven Hills West Public School Assessment Schedule – Term 3, Weeks 9 and 10

Dear Parents,

During Weeks 9 and 10, assessments will be completed by all students in K-2 and Support Unit classes at Seven Hills West Public School. These assessments will assess the literacy and numeracy learning of students.

The results of the tests will provide important information about what each student can do and will be used to support teaching and learning programs. This will assist teachers in assessment of students, indicating their level of achievement.

All tests will be completed online. It is very important that students complete each assessment individually WITHOUT the assistance of parents or other members of the household. It is important to communicate to students that they need not be anxious about the assessments and that they should not feel discouraged if they find some questions difficult. It is as important to uncover what students cannot do yet, as it is to identify what they already know and can do.

Students will use their existing Mathletics passwords to log onto the Mathletics assessments (please ask your child's teacher if you do not have access to this password). PAT assessment passwords will be given to students via a private message on Seesaw and will be put on their Google Classroom Slides on Monday September 6th 2021.
