Dear Parents and Caregivers,

On **Friday, 11th February**, our school will be holding our Swimming Carnival at the Blacktown Leisure Centre, Stanhope Gardens, in conjunction with Seven Hills North Public School, Marayong Heights Public School, and The Meadows Public Schools.

The carnival is for students in Years 3-6 as well those students in Year 2 who are turning 8 years old in (born in 2014). However, the carnival will be attended by **competitors only** who are competent swimmers, **capable of swimming 50 metres or more UNASSISTED**. Parents/Caregivers who wish their child to attend this day are to complete the entry form and permission note attached. While at the pool all students will be under the supervision of pool lifeguards and staff from Seven Hills West Public School, Seven Hills North Public School, Marayong Heights Public School, and The Meadows Public Schools.

Students will be required to arrange their own transport to and from the carnival.

Where: Blacktown Leisure Centre, Stanhope Gardens - Stanhope Parkway @ Sentry Dr, Stanhope Gardens.

When: Friday, 11th February 2022

Cost: \$10.00 (pool entry and hire cost)

Travel: If you are unable to transport your child to and from the carnival, please speak to Miss Cole to organise private transport with a staff member

What to wear: Full school Sports uniform (swimmers can be worn underneath uniform), closed-in shoes to and from venue.

What to bring: Swimming costume, towel, goggles (optional), recess, lunch, plenty of drinks (water) in a plastic bag with all belongings labelled with name. **Canteen will not be accessible by students on the day.**

Please complete and return the form attached to your child's teacher by **Wednesday, 15th December 2021**. Please note that as it is a 25m pool at Blacktown Leisure Centre, students will need to complete 2 laps of the pool in a 50m race. **Please note that due to COVID restrictions, spectators will not be allowed on the day.**
