As part of our showcase for Term 2, your child will be developing a documentary-style video about their own personal journey.

We require your assistance in developing this project. To assist your child, they may be asking you some questions about their family history, and we also ask you help them source some photos or videos that could be used to develop their “personal journey videos”.

We ask that you use one of the following methods to send the photos and videos in;

- Copy them on to a USB and send in a marked plastic bag.
- Email them to the school email sevenhillw-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au and address the email to your child’s class teacher.
- Send them through Class Dojo or Seesaw (depending on what your class uses).

Stage 2 Transdisciplinary Program – ‘Where We Are in Place and Time’ – ‘7 Habits Self-Documentary Exhibition’:

This series of History, English and Creative and Performing Arts lessons are a part of the transdisciplinary unit, ‘Where We Are in Place and Time’. This learning quest will provide an orientation in place and time; personal histories; homes and journeys; the discoveries, explorations, and migrations of humankind; the relationship between and the interconnectedness of individuals and civilizations, from local and global perspectives.

Students will learn about the following key ideas:

- Why people migrate from one place to another.
- The emotional impact of people migrating.
- The effects of emigration and immigration.

The showcase will be taking place in Week 10, and we invite you to come along and view the videos the students create. More information about the showcase date will be released soon.
