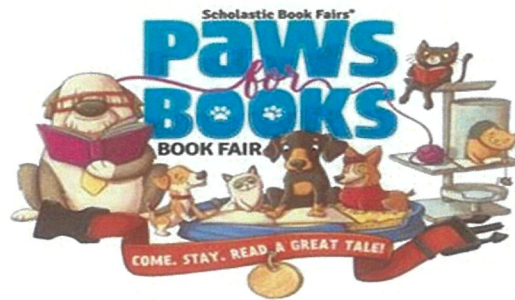

3. Complete the Pre-payment Form, including the receipt number and amount paid. This form must be returned to the school during the Book Fair.
